➤ 2 credits in <i>Professional Ethics</i> (Junior-Senior)	➤ 4 credits in <i>Advanced Chinese</i> required by the Department (Sophomore-Senior)

**Notes:**

1. *Introduction to the Bible as Literature* or *Greek and Roman Mythology*: at least one must be taken.
2. **Foreign Language**: Students who meet the language proficiency level of GEPT High Intermediate (B2) or its equivalent may enroll in second foreign language courses (8 credits); otherwise, see page 18, article III. 2 under Graduation Benchmark Enforcement Rules.
3. *Philosophy of Life* must be taken before *Professional Ethics* (or at least in the same semester).
4. Of the 31 credits required in Department Advanced Courses, students must complete at least **3 credits** in Advanced Literature and Culture courses and at least **3 credits** in Advanced Language Studies courses.
