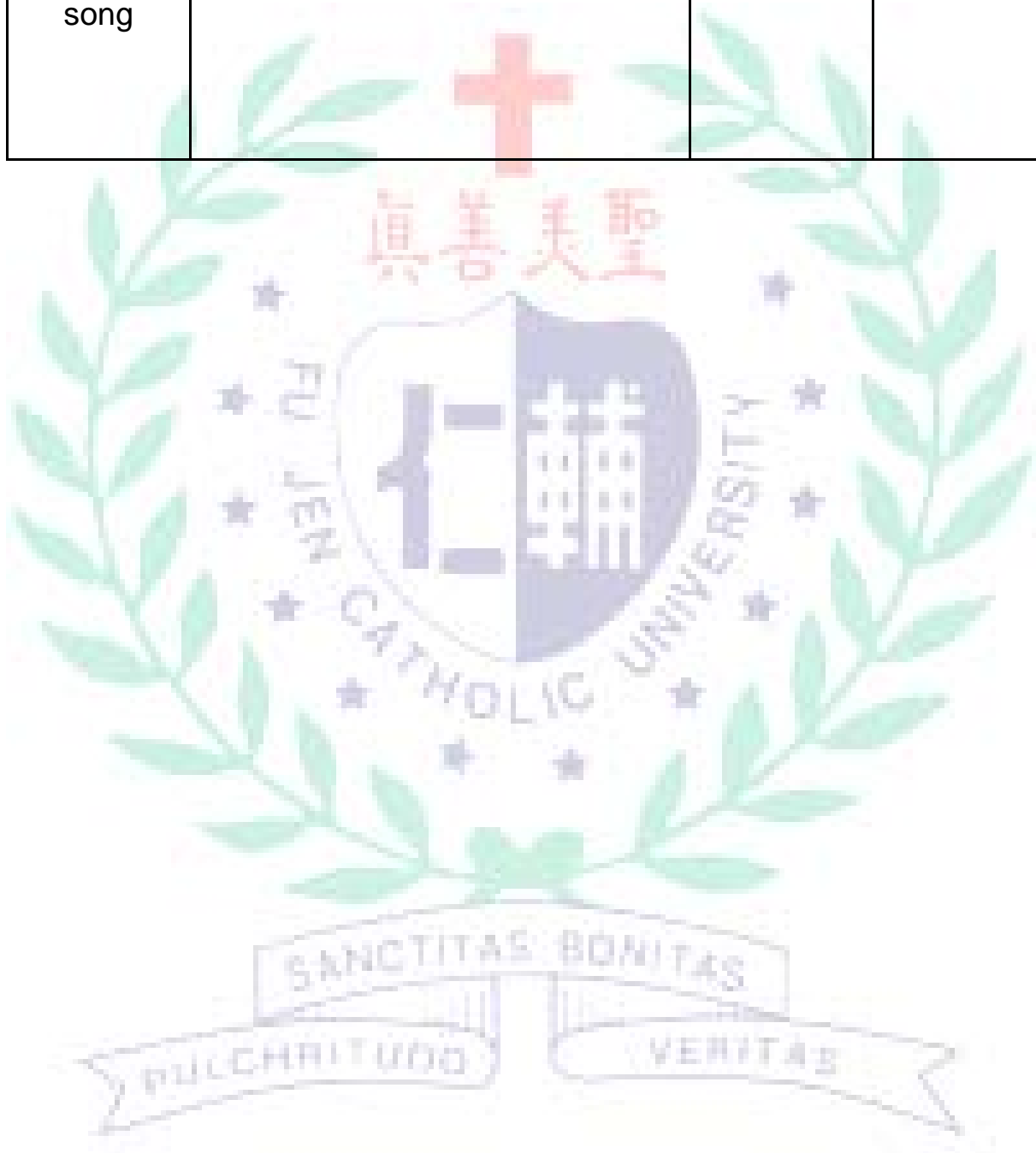

Vocabulary	red, yellow, blue, pink, purple, green, brown, silver, gold, etc.
