Take an instance, sometimes I might be available to the rehearsal, I needed to make the negotiation with my other director assistant partner, Eunice. Thus, I had to communicate with her properly and divided the job clearly so as to make sure the rehearsal can go on. But sometimes the thing does not always go well as you think. I had one quarrel with one of the staff members because of the miscommunication. Back then, I needed to take care of actors' meal and helped to place their order to the sub stage manager. However, due to the tight rehearsal schedule, I missed the bento order because I did not have time to get close to them and enquire their needs. It ended up that the others staff members had to yield their bento to the actors and I ran out to purchase bento for the staff member. I was blamed by the sub stage manager. It turned out that I was annoyed by him and meanwhile I did not have my meal and got to work without my empty stomach. The reason I was unhappy was that I had already said my apologies to those who I messed up their meals, but he still show hostile to me. I truly learned a lecture from this experience. Above these problems I had faced with, to tell the truth, it truly brought some negative memories to me, nevertheless, still, it would not bother me that most my good memories with the others will leave a good impression in my heart.



To conclude, even though it sounded there are pros and cons to join the senior

play crew, frankly speaking, I will do the same choice if I had the second chance. This precious experience really brings lots of good things to me. As the pictures I have shown on the left
