I. Introduction of the Group Project

A. Introduction

Our project aims to promote some Taipei tourist spots to foreign backpackers and those who come from other cities in Taiwan. Moreover, we try to avoid those famous tourist spot and cost down the whole itinerary. In order to create a more useful and interesting website for them to browse, we use several different applications, such as Cacao, Aurasma, scratch, and audacity, to add colors to our projects.

B. Motivation and Background Information

In the very beginning when we were assigned to do the final project, our group discussed and voted which type of social issue we had more interest in. Then, the media and education was the most chosen. After further discussion, we decided to hold a summer camp in Australia's language school. However it happened to be too general. Therefore, we started to think about how could we combine traveling with the software. Finally, we thought of solving the problems that Taiwan tourism has confronted with. We wanted to design an economical itinerary for promoting Taipei, the capital of Taiwan, to some foreign backpackers and even for those who come from other cities in Taiwan. Below are the motivations and the purposes of making this project.

1. Our goal is to let backpackers have better choices when visiting Taipei City and let them get a further understanding of Taipei City.
2. Our target audiences are backpackers who aren't from Taipei City and

foreign backpackers.

3. Our project aims to solve backpackers' problem and avoid crowded people, tourist attractions, and traffic problems.

4. Our itinerary enables backpackers to spend no more than NT\$3,500.

II. Project Content Explanations:

A. Group Focus:

Every member in our group serves as a famous blogger and also a trip planner. We designed a three-day itinerary for backpackers to follow. We mainly focus on some places that local people would like to go. Then, each of our members takes charge of one to two spots and organizes and provides the detailed information for backpackers. Also, we provide our personal cards with contact information, which are made by *Easel.ly*. Furthermore, we utilize some different apps, including *Aurasma*, *Audacity*, *Cacoo*, and *Scratch*, according to each member's need for their schedule design.

B. My Main Focus

I am in charge of the schedule in the first day, and I provide information about Lao Di Fant viewing platform and Ningxia night market. In my part, I give the information about the location, the opening hour, the history, and so on. I use *Google Site* to show the result of the project. In order to provide those who browse our website to get access to us, each of us use *Easel.ly* to create a contact card. Besides, I am responsible for combining our project with the icon-collecting activity, so I utilize *Aurasma* to put the icon, which represents Taipei City, to the landmarks of the spots we introduce, and backpackers can

scan the landmarks to collect the icon and get the prize. For my subpages, I use *Audacity* to record some parts of the content, in case readers are not willing to read the whole paragraph.

C. Self-valuation of My Group Project

In the beginning, I was a little lost with the project, and I did not know what I had to do very well. However, after several times of discussion, I gradually got the idea. Then, I started to evaluate which apps or software can help our project, and this is why I decided to use those applications. I think our group project provides very complete information of each spots, and offer clear explanations about what we wanted to achieve in the project. Moreover, the apps and software used also add colors to the project. Those apps and software well help us convey our ideas about the project.

III. Apps and Software Adopted in the Group Project

A. My Role and Coordination

I am the representative, who has to promote our project and attracts more people to attend our trip. Besides, I am also the trip planner and the blogger. I have to meet with my group members and discuss how to organize the sequence of visiting the spots we recommend. Also, after the meeting, I have to make up my own subpage. 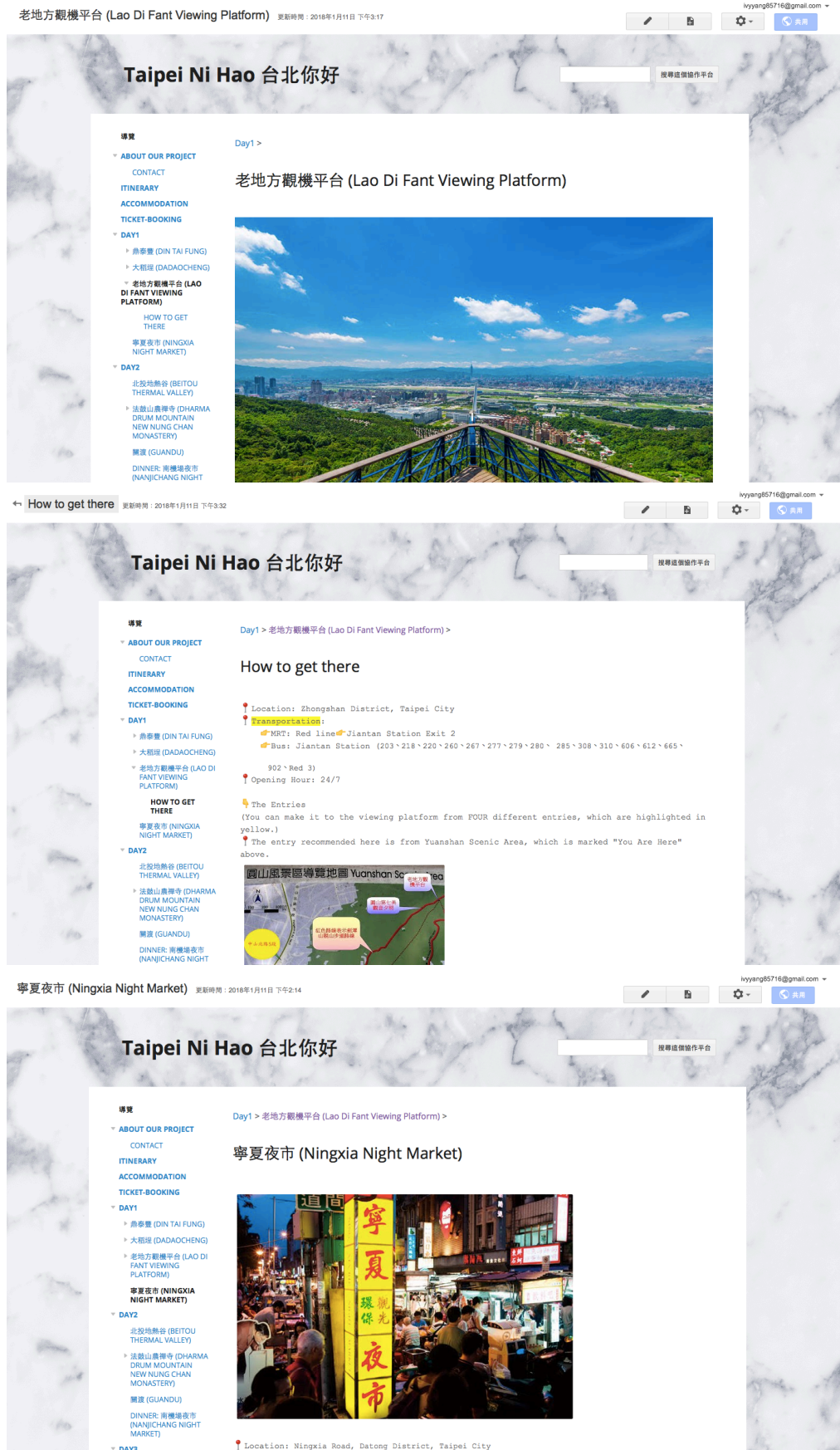

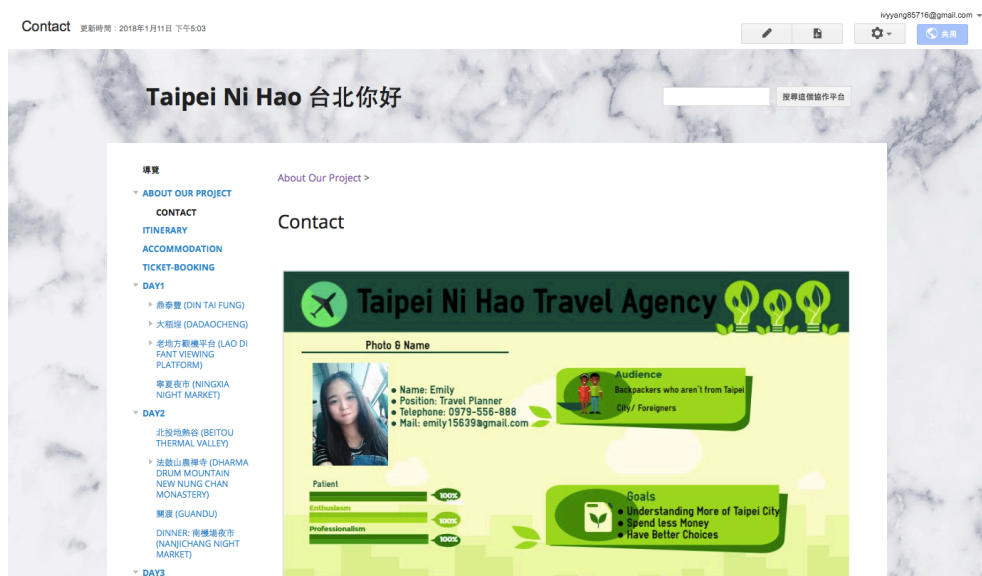


The screenshots above show how I show my final project through Google Site.

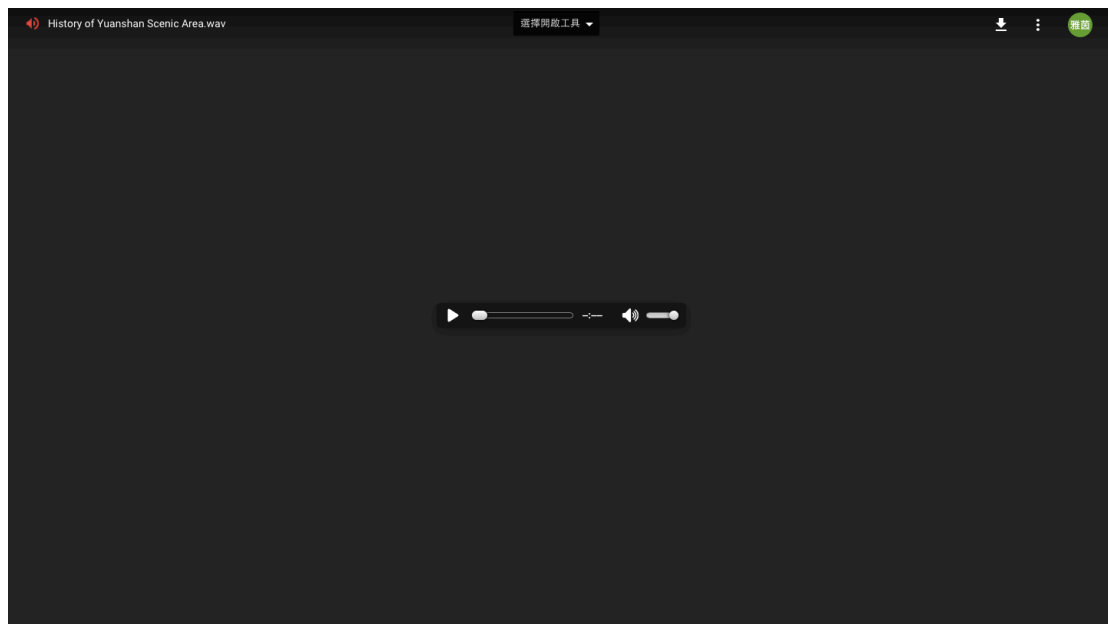

I put the *Audacity* document under Lao Di Fant viewing platform. I add the hyperlink to the sound icon, and when the readers click to it, it will lead them to the Google drive and listen to the sound track. In this part, I use Audacity to record the history of Lao Di Fant viewing platform.

Continuing walking forward, you'll come to a place called Old Place. There is a large rock with "Lao-Di-Fant" in Chinese inscribed in red and the shape of Taiwan inscribed in white. Lao-Di-Fant in Chinese means "old place."



It used to be a leisure pavilion, but the pavilion was taken down in order to build a lookout. You can see planes taking off and landing in Songshan Airport from here. Although Jian-tan Hiking Trail was restored by the city government, it isn't quite as refined as Xiang-shan Hiking Trail. All the military facilities are gone. On your way downhill, there is an inconspicuous and small path that will take you to Ming-chuan University. You'll still be able to see the old patrol path paved with cement blocks there.

The *Aurasma* document is placed under Lao Di Fant viewing platform. We encourage readers to collect the icon, which is shown in the screenshot above.

I looked for the icon, which can represent Taipei City, and add the overlay onto the landmarks. If readers go to the places, they can use the Aurasma app on their smartphones to scan the landmark and collect the icon. Aurasma is also a friendly application, and I was in charge of teaching Aurasma in my previous tutorial presentation, so I did not have problems making the Aura.

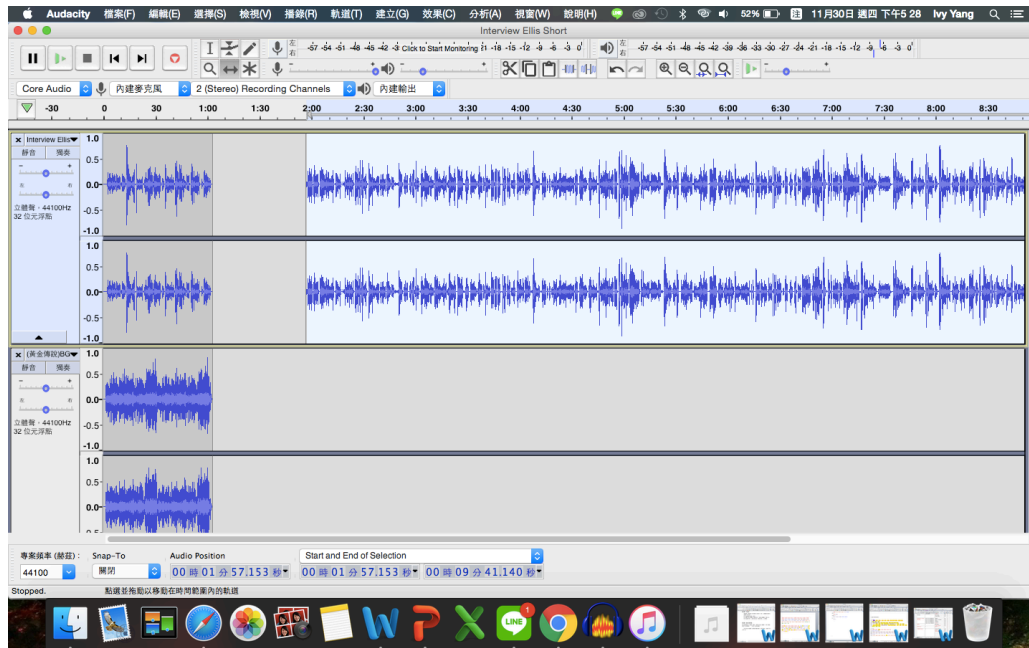
C. Audacity

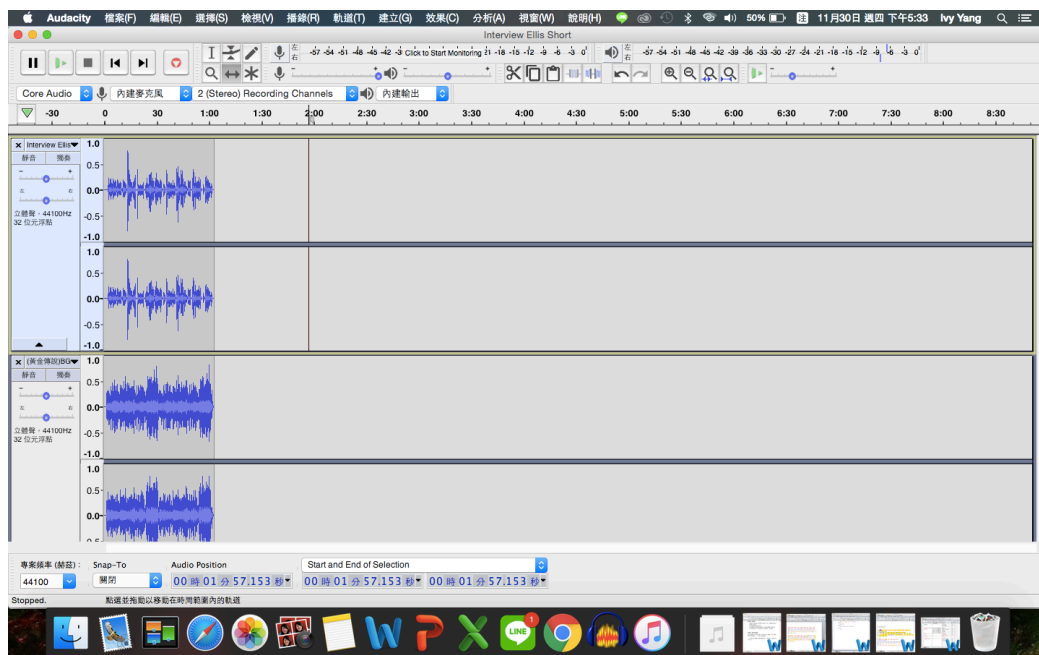

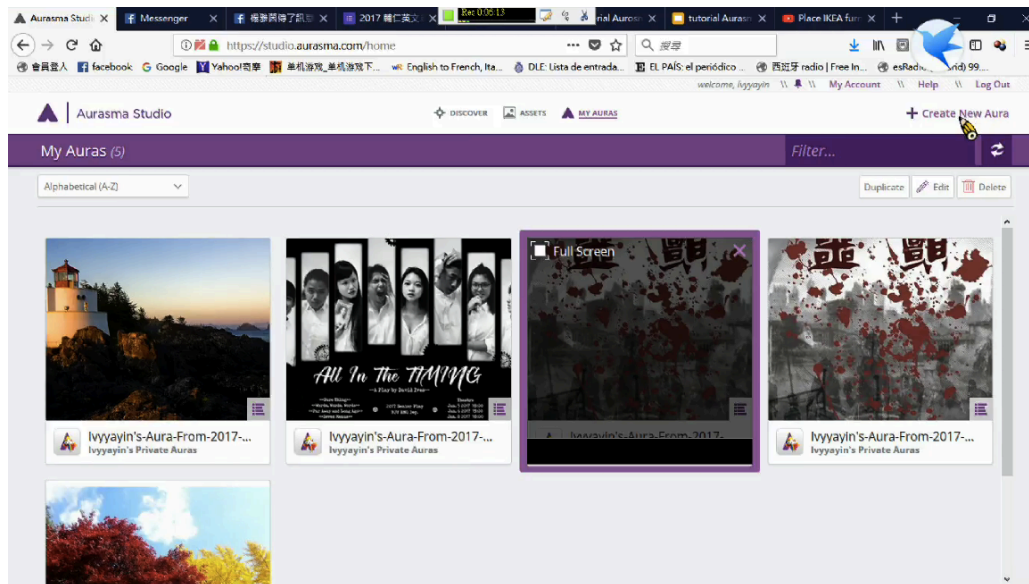
D. Aurasma

Founder & Origins

During the Chinese Civil War, in 1948, 楊果勝 decided to get on the ship from Shanghai to Taiwan when he was 21. With the help from his aunt, he got the first job in Taiwan. The job was to deliver goods in oil store which is called 恒泰豐. After working for ten years, due to the investment failure, the boss of 恒泰豐 had no choice but to announce for going bankrupt.

Under this situation, 楊果勝 then started a business with his wife in order to make a living. He also opened an oil store which is called 鼎泰豐油行, the combination of the name of where he got the stock of oil (鼎泰油行) and where he had worked in (恒泰豐). The business went smoothly owing to good relationship with others and word of mouth. However, in 1972, cracked oil appeared in the market, which had an impact on the store. Fortunately, with the suggestion from the boss in 復興區, they started to sell both oil and dumpling at the same time. Relying on building the store's image for genuineness and quality ingredients, they succeed for the business. They then stopped selling oil and continued to sell dumpling.

The story for Din Tai Fung then started.

In the past, Dadaocheng was one of flourishing commercial areas in Taipei. Yet, it actually went through a period of decline during last decades. Nevertheless, now, it flourishes again since it is a place where it combines traditional commerce with historical sites. Before the Chinese New Year, you will see lots of people coming there to do the shopping for New Year. This area will be more busier than usual. If you have chance to go there during this time, you can taste Taiwanese spirit and traditions!

The range of "Dadaocheng" is on the east side of Huanhe North Road, on the south side of Minquan West Road, on the west side of Chongqing North Road, and on the north side of Zhongxiao West Road. The district has a long history for about hundred years. Wandering on the streets, you will discover that apart from some long-established stores, some special stores are there as well. They are meant to create strong cultural and humanistic atmosphere for this area.

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

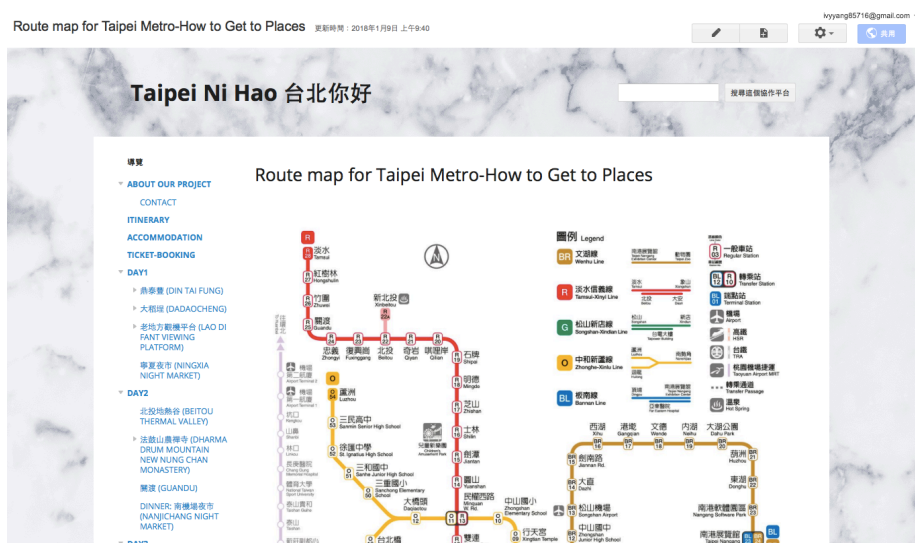
Known as the most scenic spot in Taipei to drink quality, locally grown tea, Maokong is a quaint village located at the top of a mountain providing breathtaking views of Taipei City.

Tea aficionados will enjoy Maokong for its variety of tea houses and high quality selection, while people looking for a relaxing break from the busy city can sit back with a cup of tea and nice dinner, all while taking in the beautiful views of Taipei.

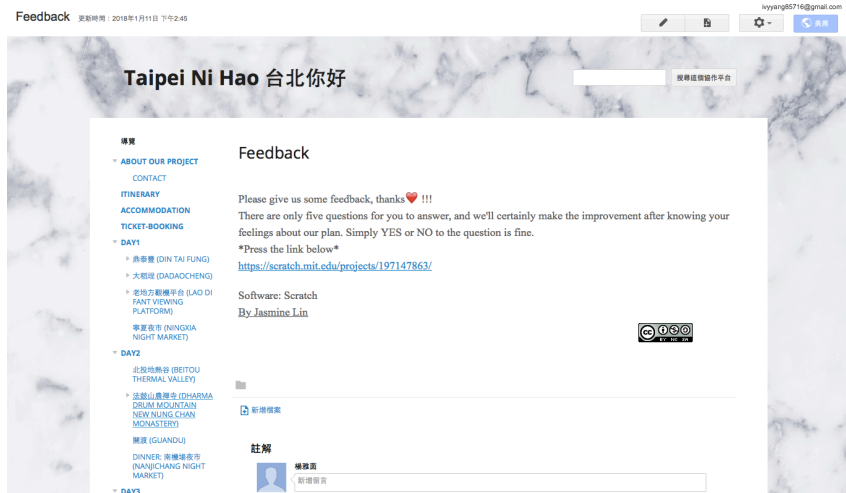
The best way to reach Maokong is to take the Maokong Gondola scenic cable car up the mountain from MRT Taipei Zoo Station. NT\$120 each way for adults. NT\$50 for children 6-12 and seniors over 65. With each adult allowed up to 2 children under 6 for free. EasyCards are given a 20% discount on weekdays, and also receive a NT\$20 discount when also used for zoo entry.
