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Introduction

My motivation to take this course is because I haven't had any English teaching experience before. Thus, I want to take teaching credits from our English Department to enhance my English teaching skills. Through the teaching theories learned and the teaching process of this course, I believe I could improve a lot in my first English teaching experience. In addition, I consider this course as my Learning Outcome Demonstration, since I would have many personal growth and teaching experience gained after the Gou-Tai elementary school service learning process.

Purposes

My students' learning motivation, what teaching theories I applied to my teaching, and the teaching processes will be presented in this portfolio. My two students' assessments will also be included. For the last part, I will show my learning outcomes and my reflection overall Gou-Tai teaching process.

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My Students' Learning Motivation

I have two students, named Kiki and Lulu. Both of them are sixth grader. In the first class, I did a mini motivation survey orally by asking them questions. Both Kiki and Lulu has low interests in learning English. They think English is hard to learn and is unwilling to study English. When I ask my students to write down the vocabulary, Kiki seems unwilling to take notes since she says that she hates writing. As for Lulu, she is more willing to write her notes down. Both of them are easily distracted by others in class. Yet, despite their weak learning motivation toward English, they always show up on time, which is a good act.

Theories Used

I used three teaching theories during my teaching process. The first theory I applied is Audiolingual. Audiolingual emphasizes the teaching of listening and speaking. Activities such as dialogues, repetition and memorization is used for learners. I find many dialogues for my students to practice speaking. I would read the dialogue first then ask them to repeat after me. Also, audio-visual aids are used as my teaching materials.

The second theory used is The Natural Approach. In this theory, topics are designed for learners needs and designed to give beginners basic communicative skills. Teaching materials come from realia rather than text-books. Since my students are easily distracted and have no interest in English, I sometimes choose YouTube videos as material rather than text-books. I ask what they are interested in, and then find out they both love Korean girl's group Twice. Thus, I find a song performed by Twice with few English lyrics in it, then teach them those lines.

The third theory I applied is Communicative Language Teaching (CLT). CLT activities involves real communication for learners. CLT encourages learners to incorporate their personal experiences into their language learning environment. Thus, I designed activities such as interviews, where students need to take turns asking and answering the questions on the handouts in pairs.

Teaching and Instructional Processes

I used PPTs, handouts, and YouTube videos as my major teaching materials. Each week I teach different units. I use some free materials from the Ministry of Education website, including dialogues, word puzzles and activities. My lesson plans will be shown below:


- Goals:

- Procedures:





- Procedures:






