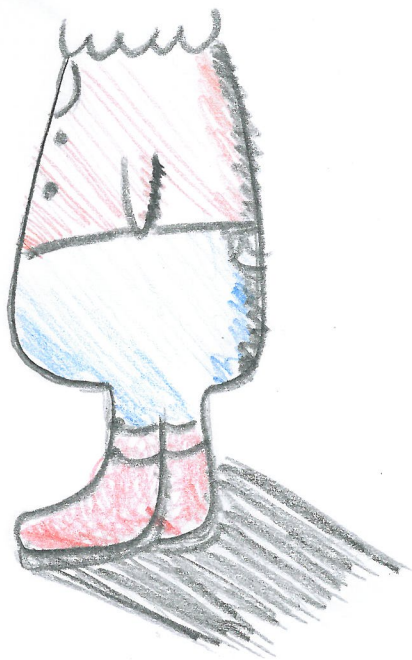

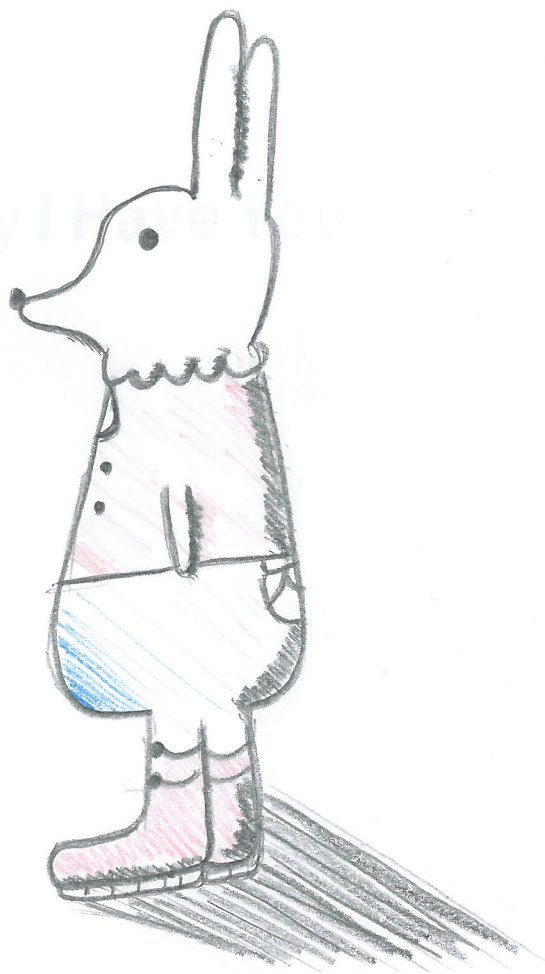
# **May I Have Your Fish?**

**Fobit likes to Make Friends.**





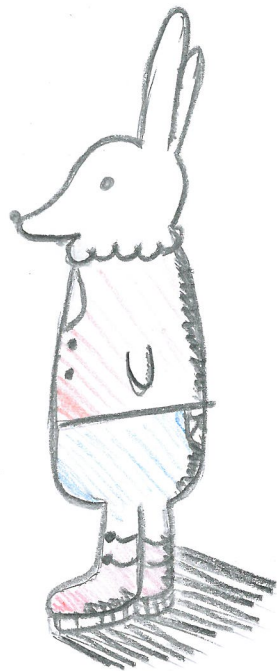
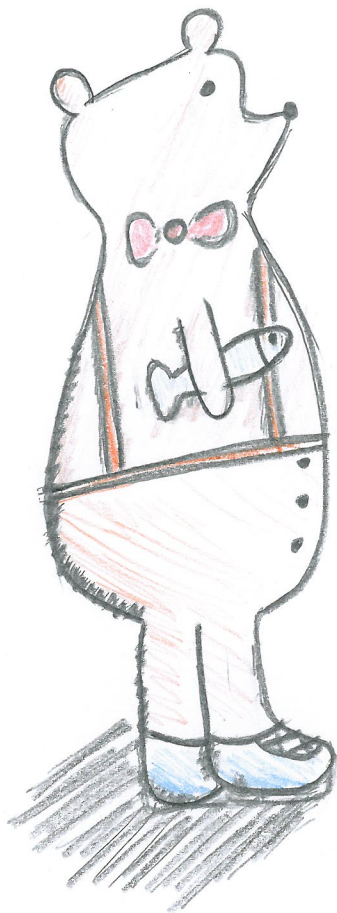
**One day, he meets a Big Bear.**

**“Then may I have your fish to become your friend? ”**

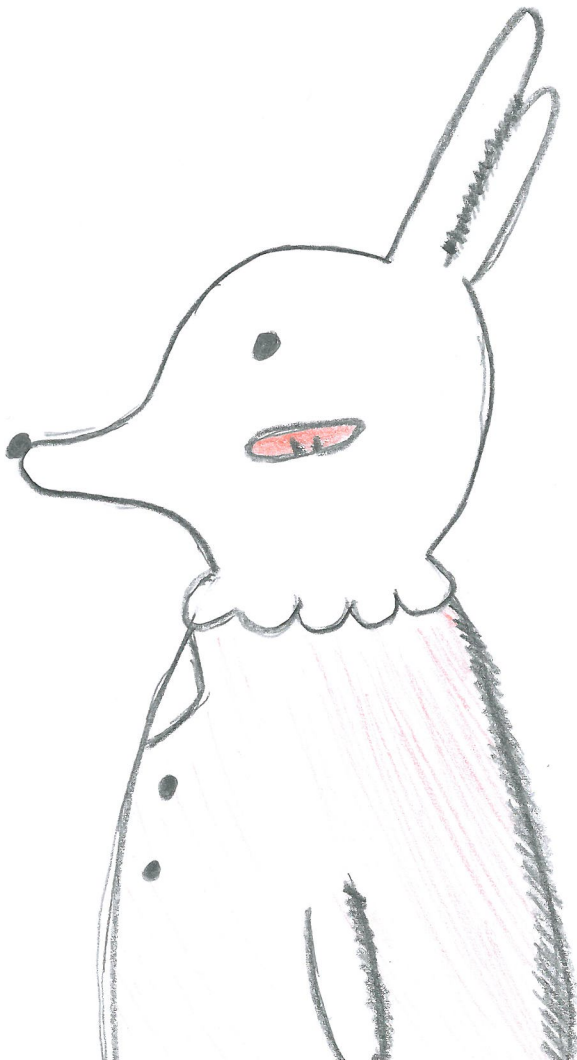


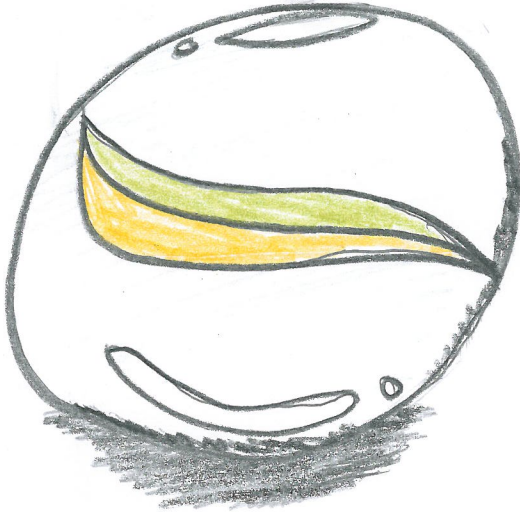
**“You have to exchange something**

**Bear accepts the marble.**

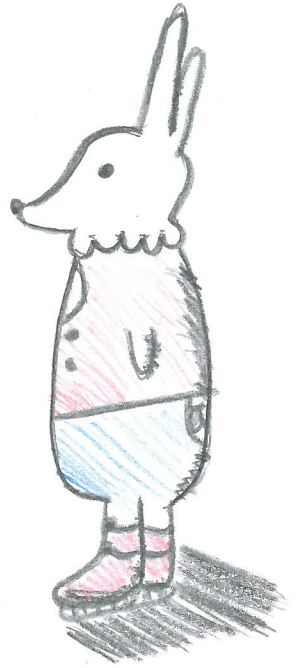
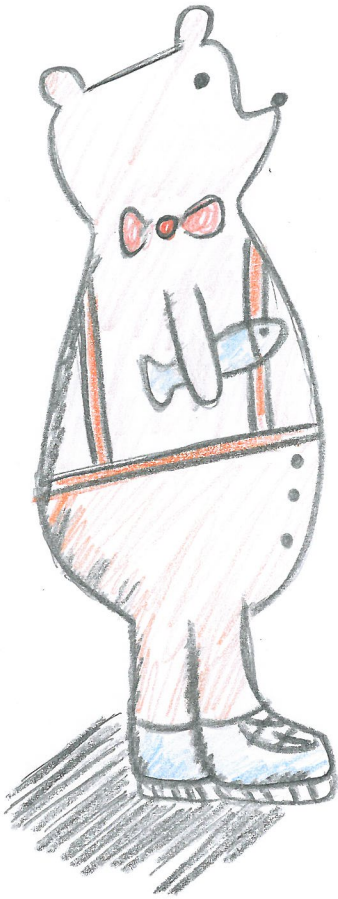

**Fobit asks.**

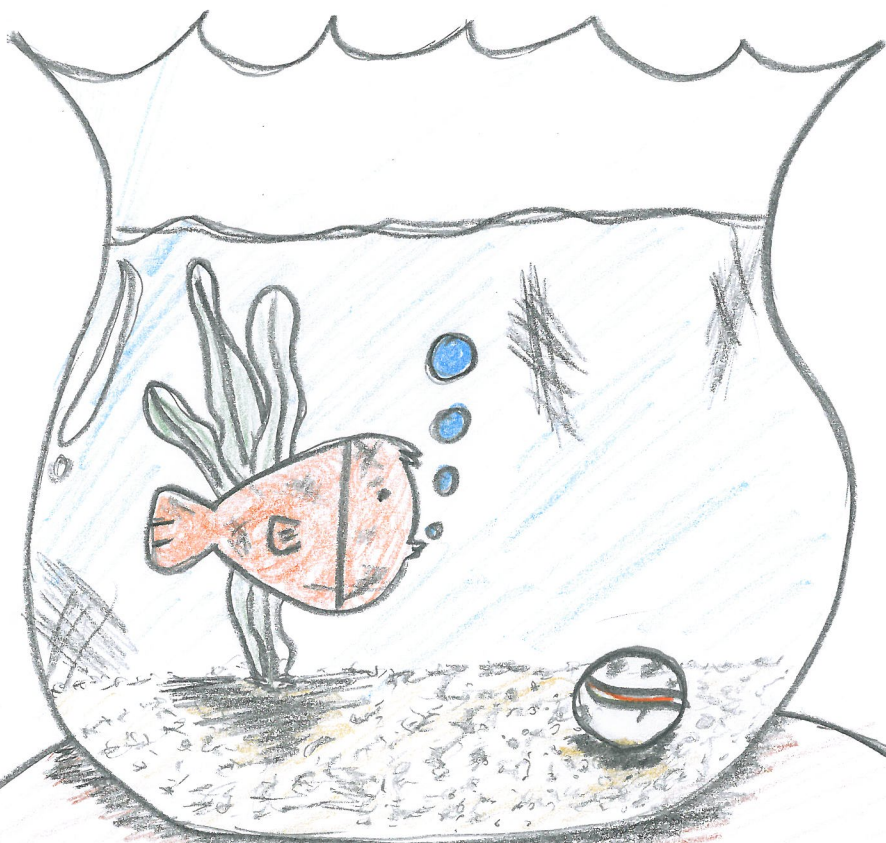
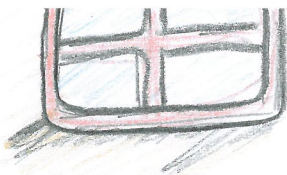
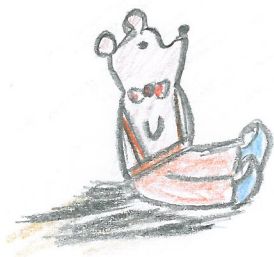

**Bear accepts the button.**

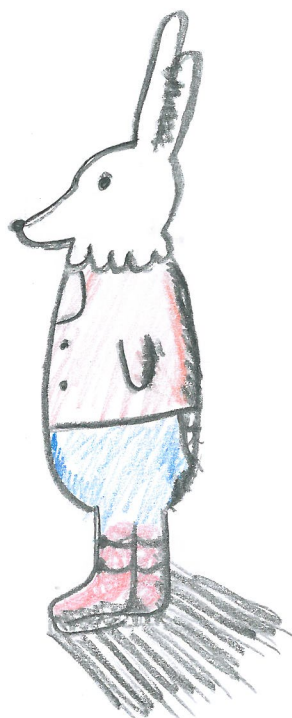
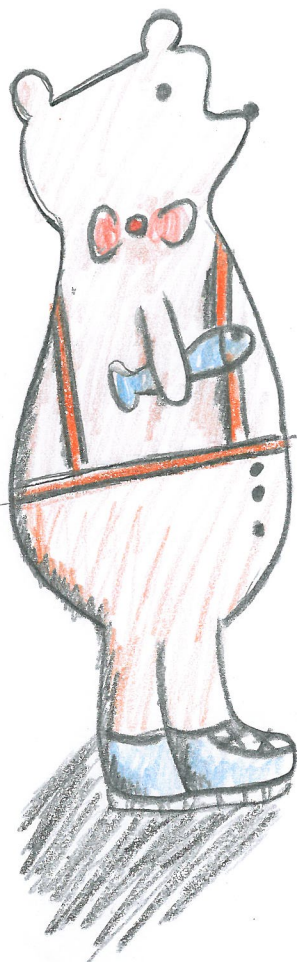

**“Oh, yes. Of course. ” Bear answers.**

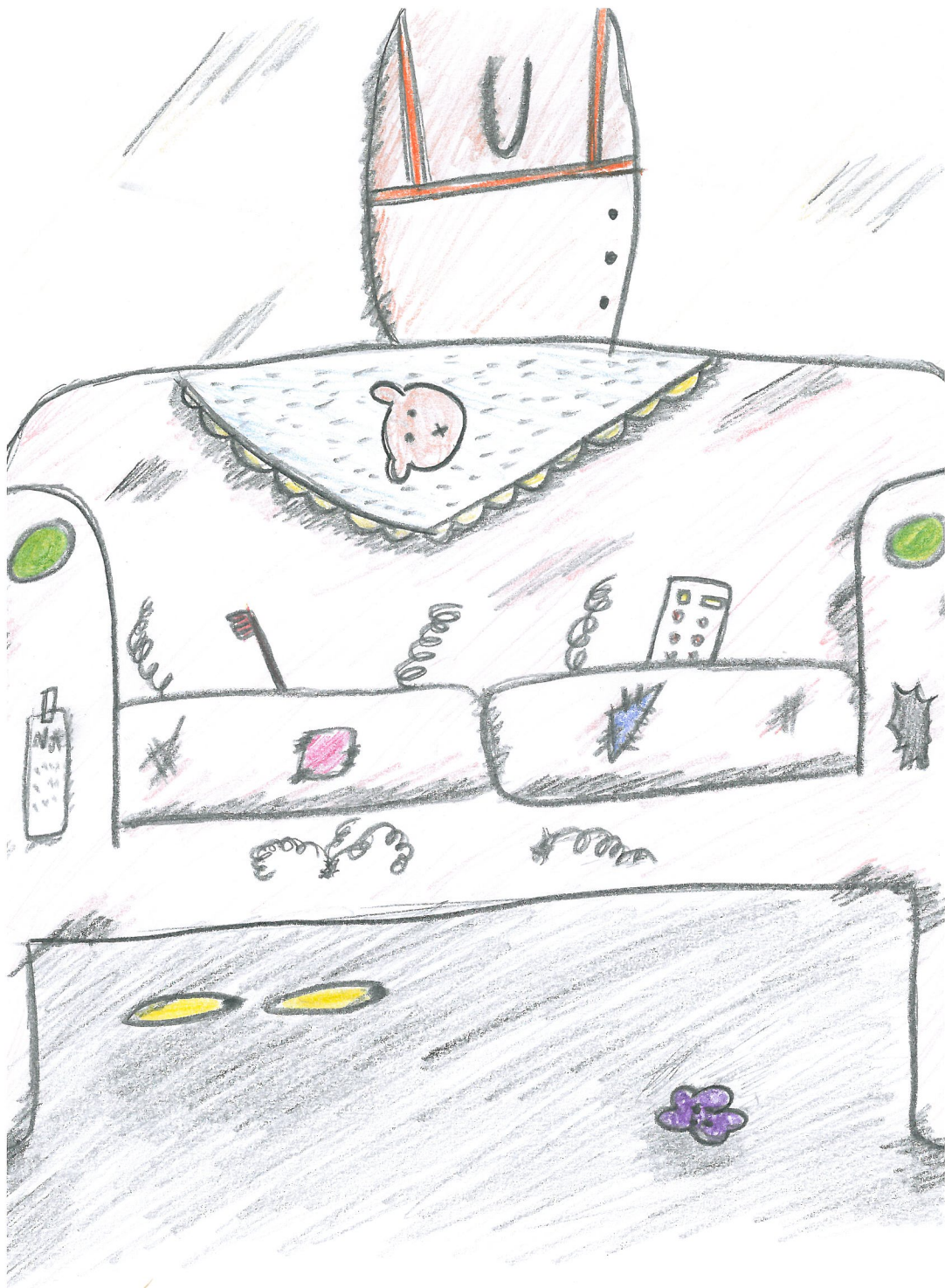

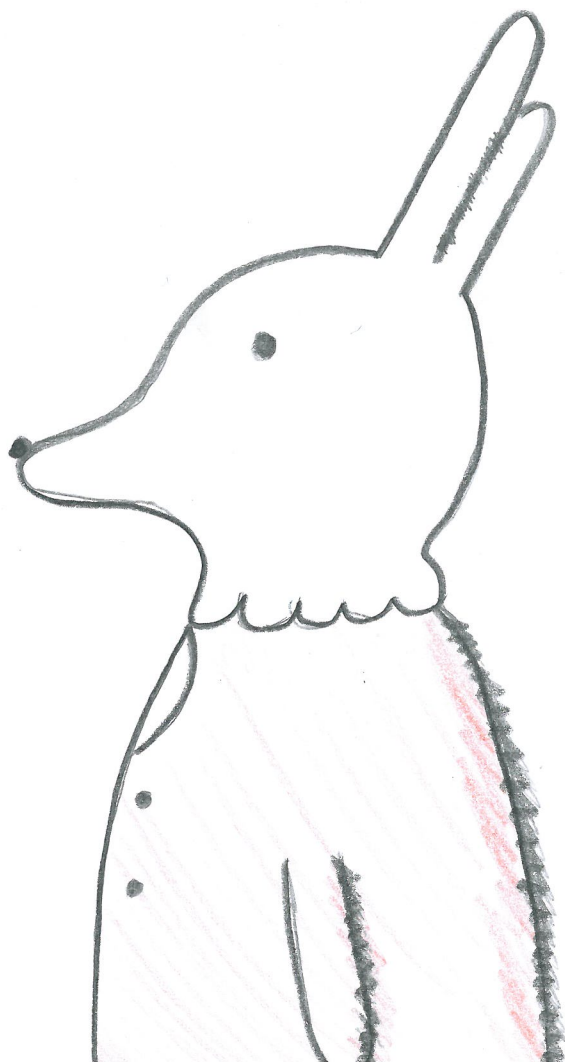

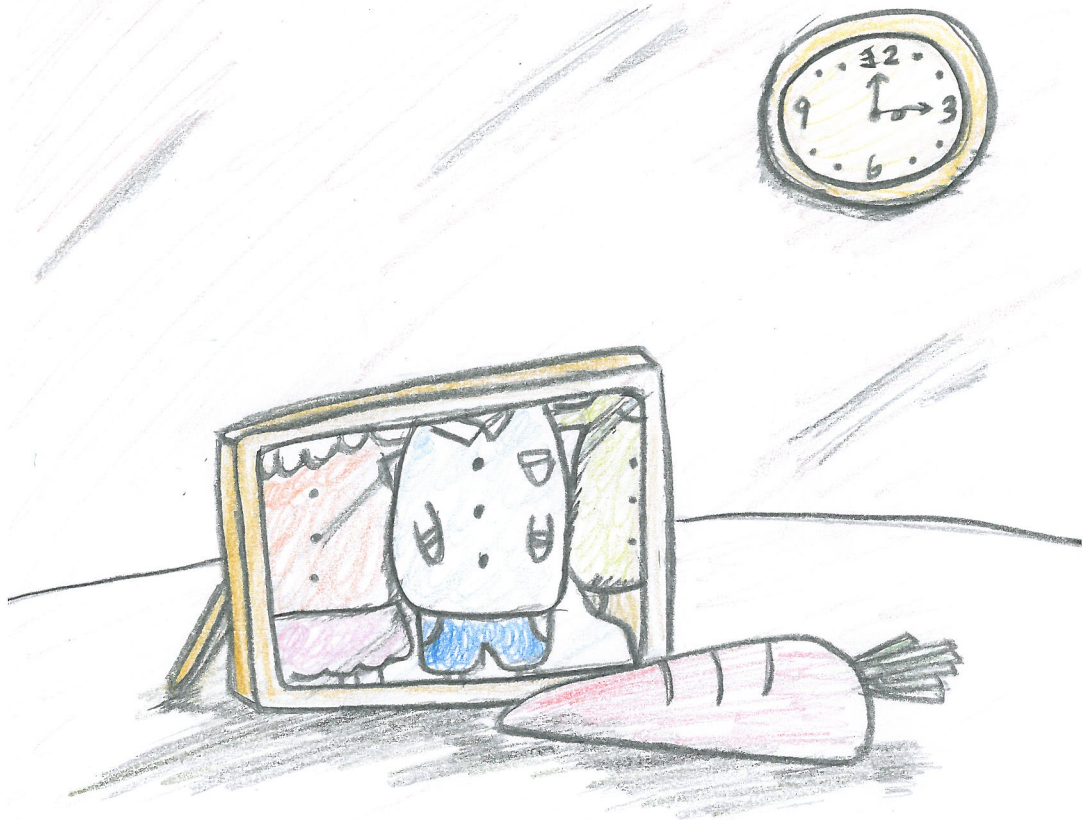

**Bear refuses.**

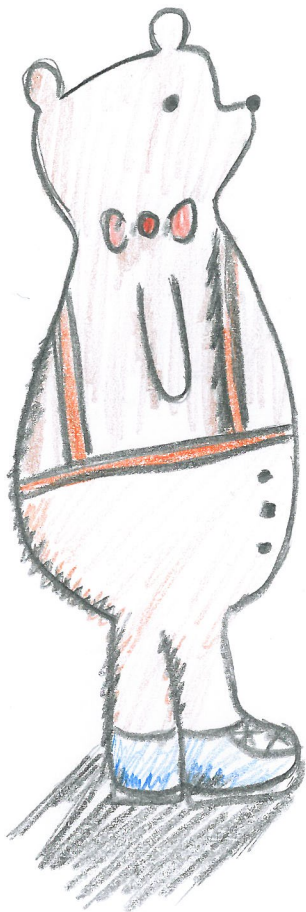
**“I gave it to someone else.” Bear says.**

**“NOTHING?” Fobit is about to cry.**

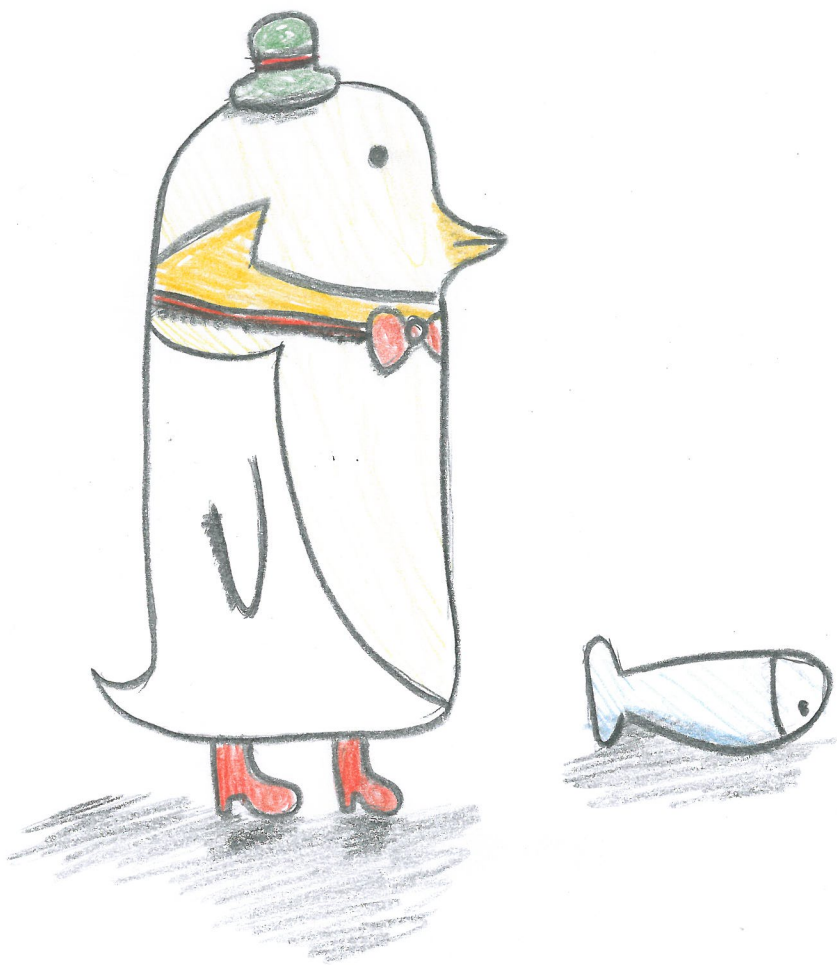
**“THEN WHY?”**



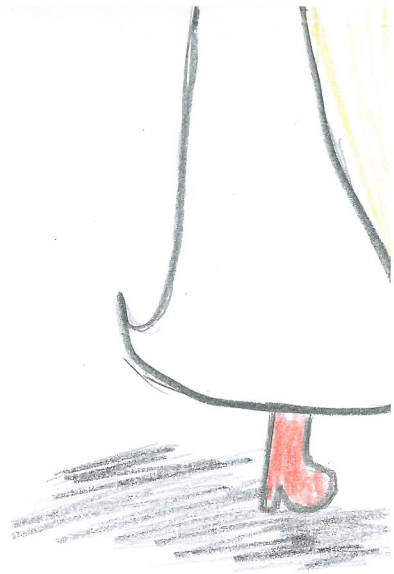
**“He has the same bow tie as I do.”**

**Bear answers.**





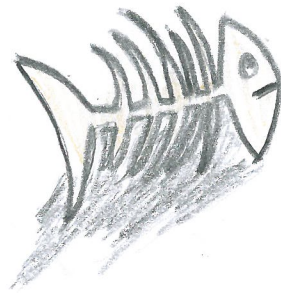
**Fobit cries.**



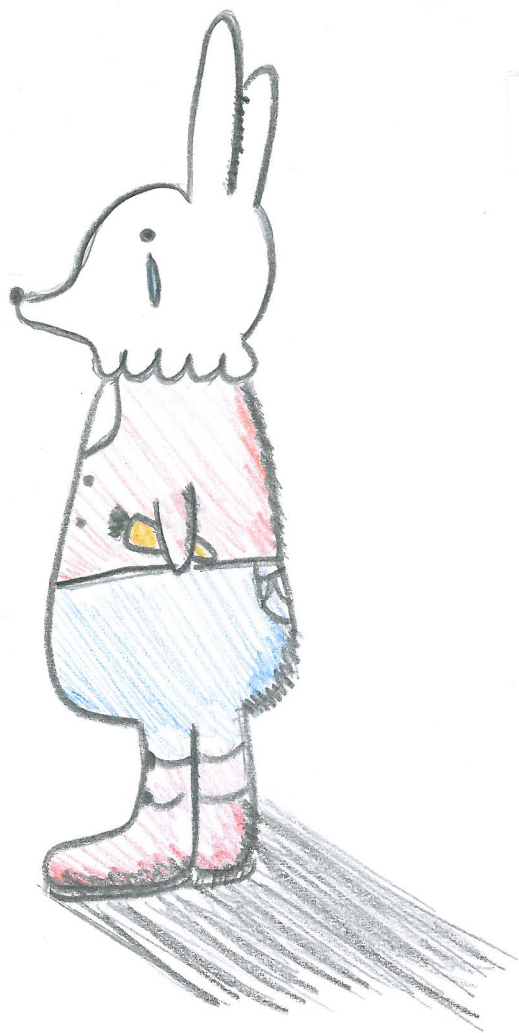

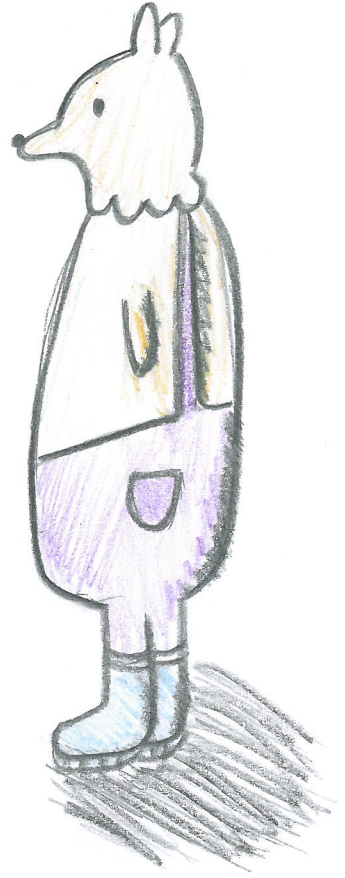
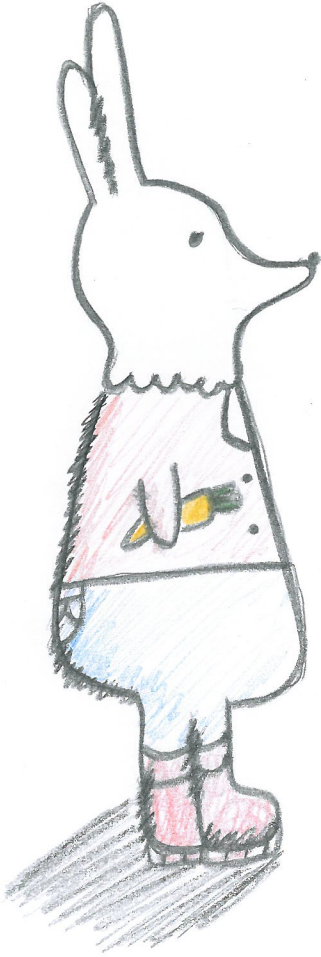




“Hey.”
