Mandy the grumpy little girl.




She feels angry, but she doesn't know why.

Benjamin the frowning little boy.




He feels sad, but he doesn't know why.

At School, Mrs. Foole warns, 'Big boys don't cry.'

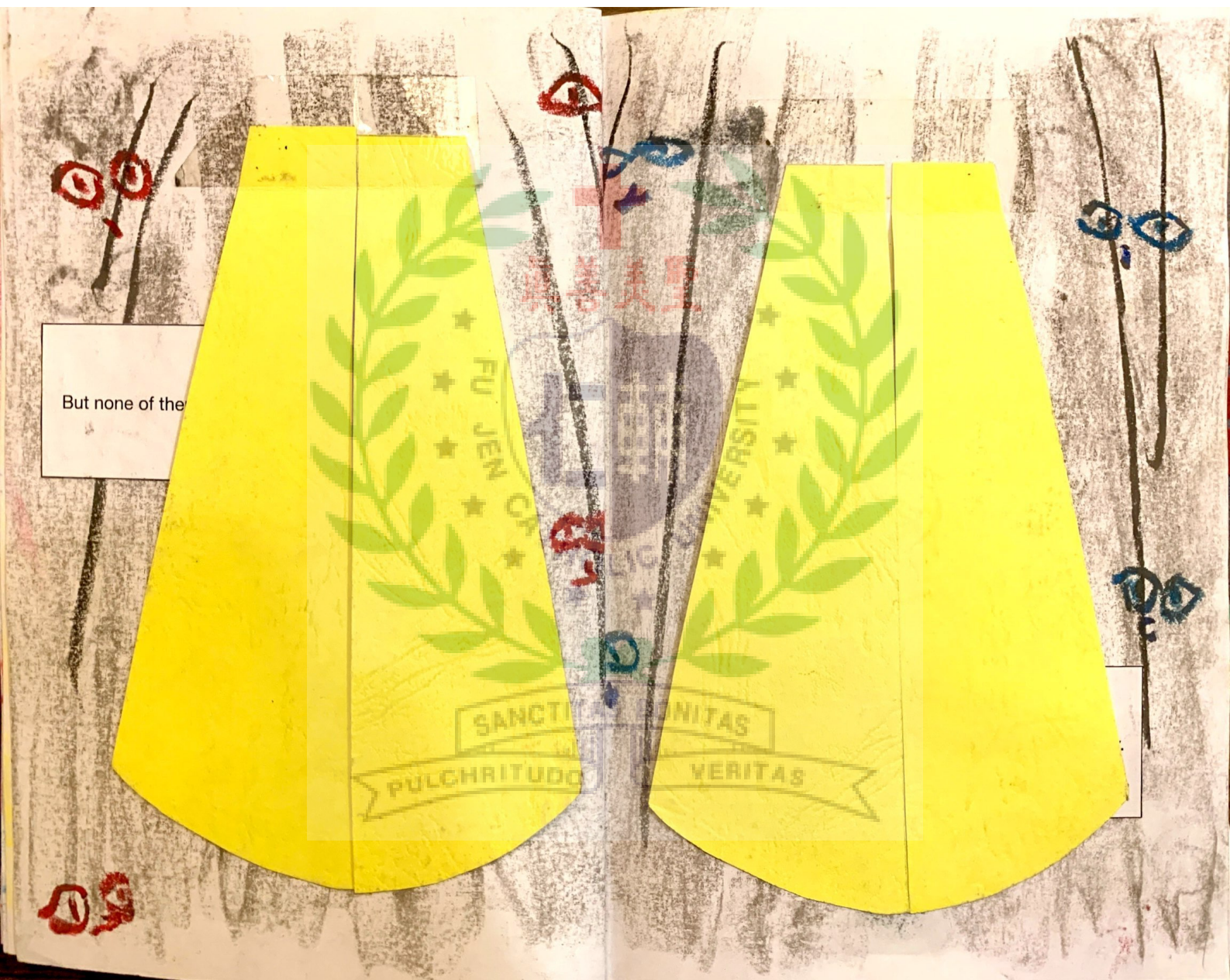
Kids mock him, 'Frowny Frownerson!'


At home, his parents would say,

are truly, truly happy.

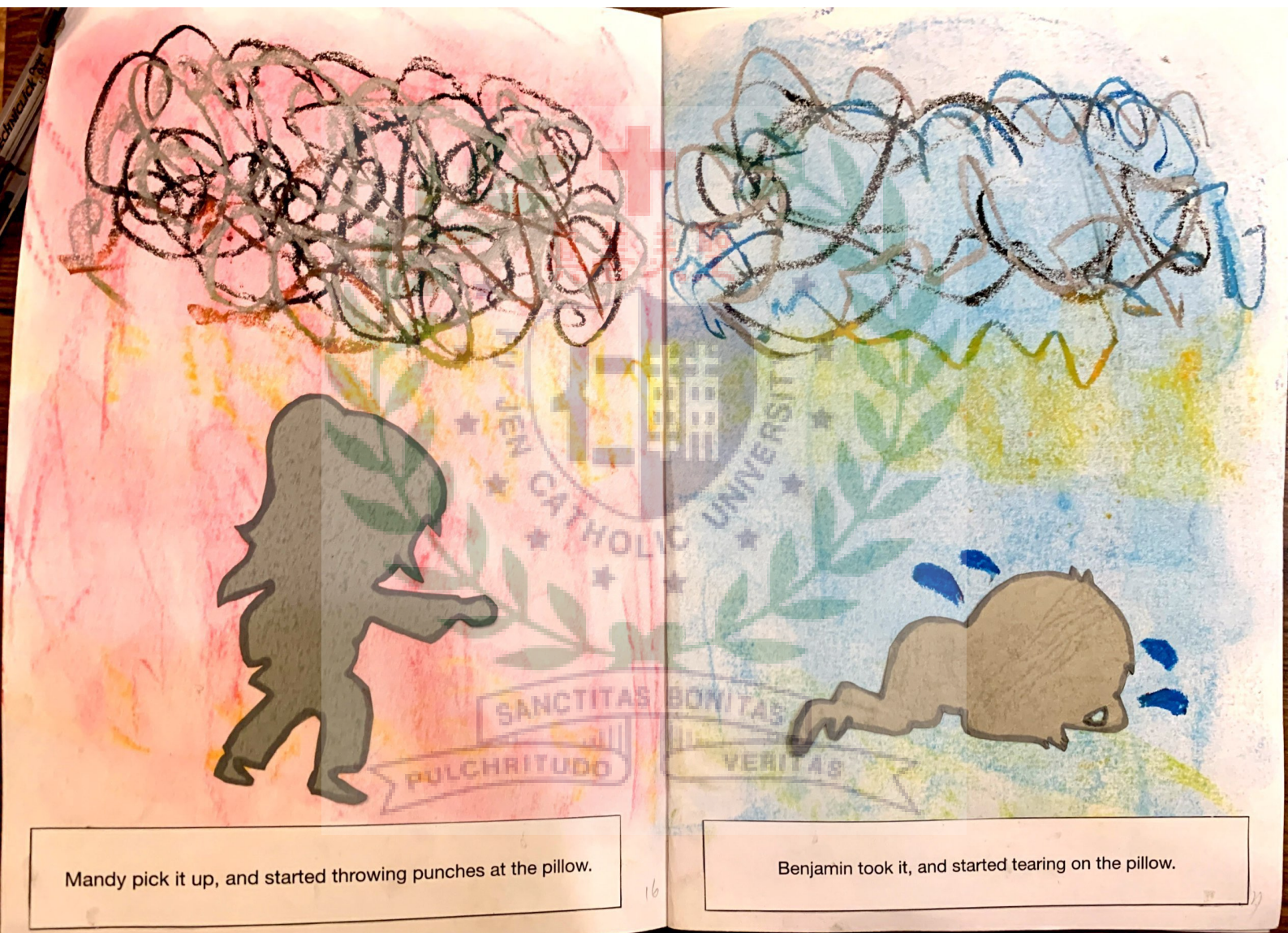




Next to a trash cart,
