Book Title: Home Sweet Home

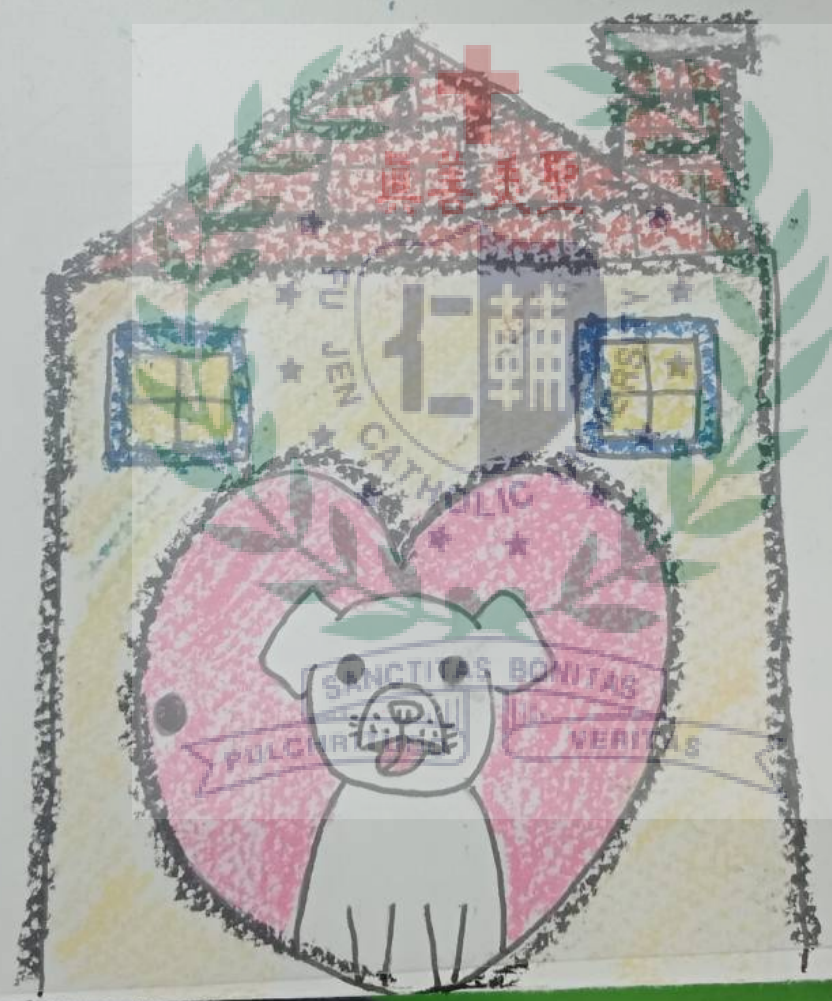

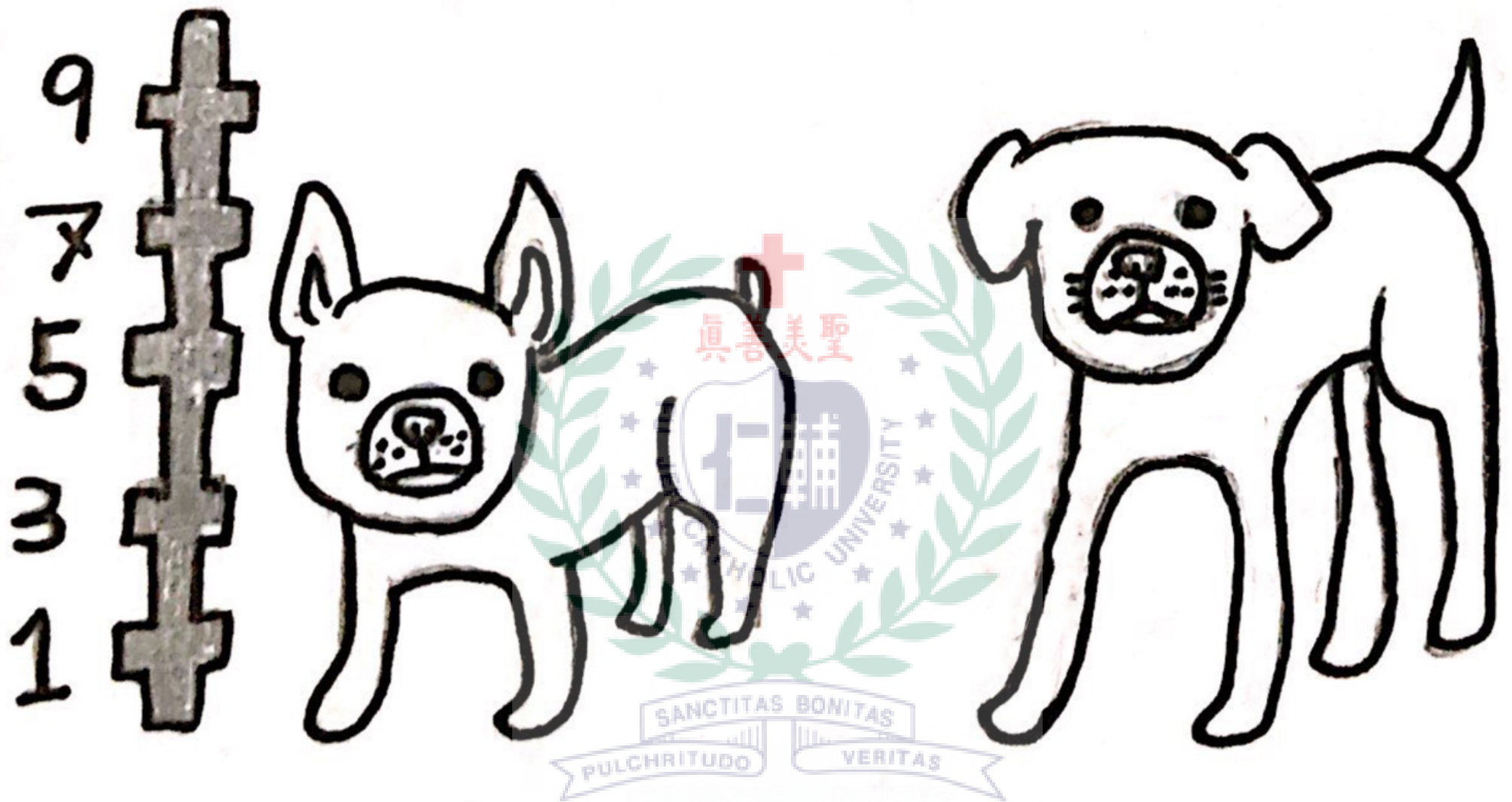
She likes to eat,

We're home!



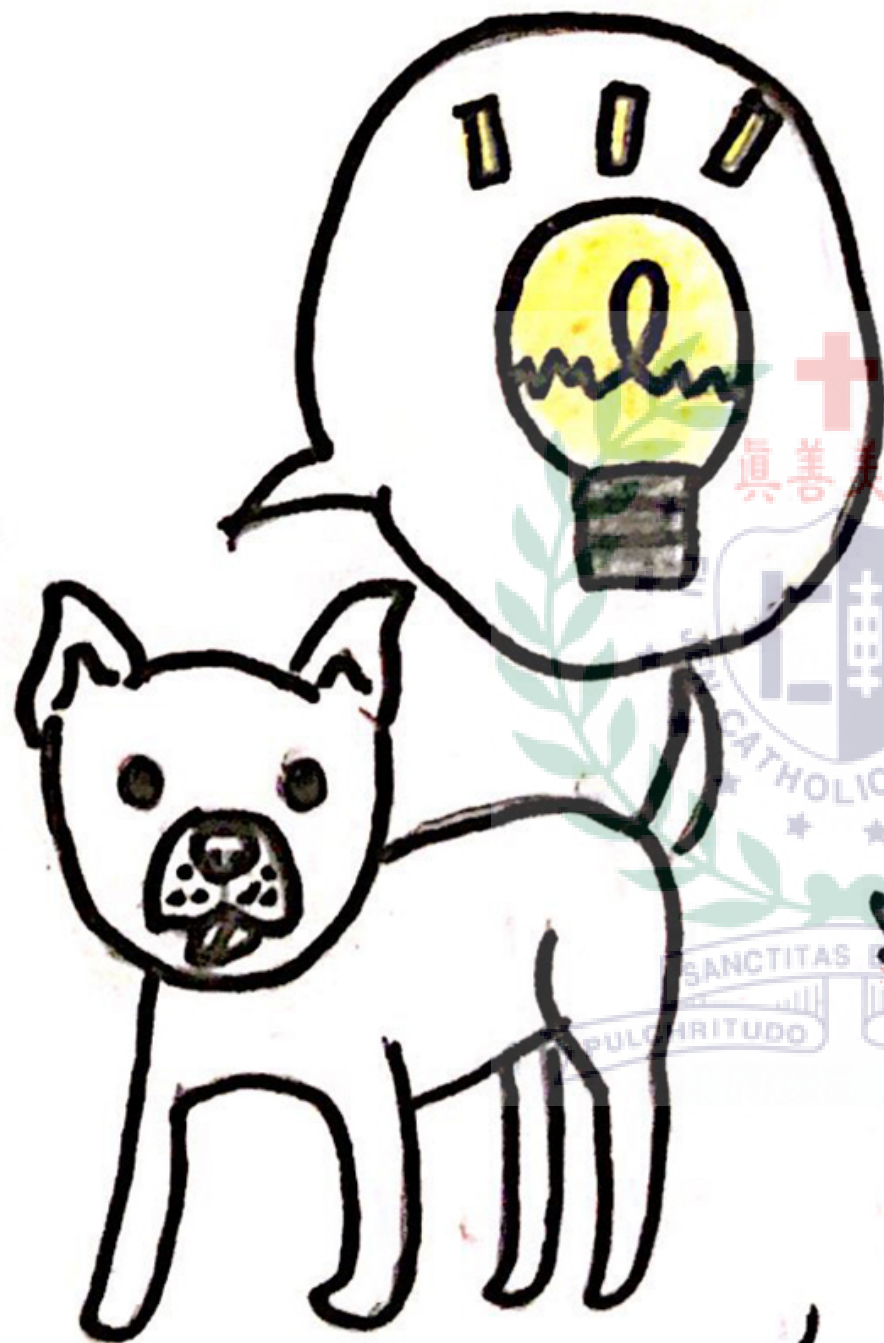
We take her out for a walk,

"I want them to be happy like me," thought White.



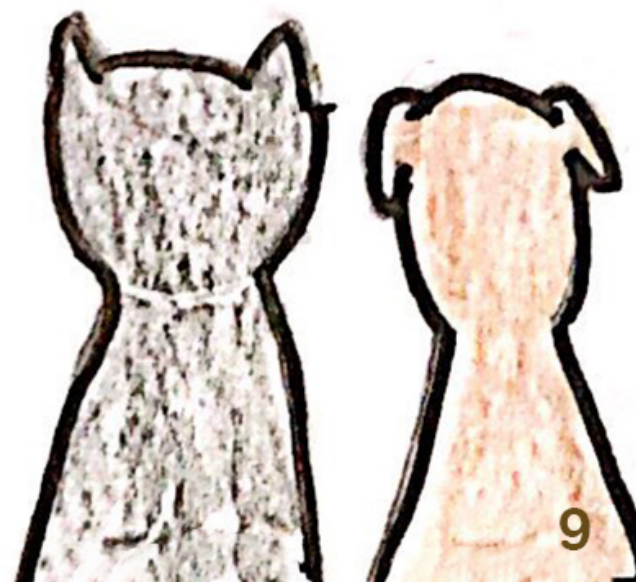


She got an idea!
